Purpose

To recommend the appointment of two municipal members and the re-appointment of one municipal member to the Essex Region Source Protection Committee (SPC)

Discussion

As required by the Clean Water Act, 2006, the Essex Region Source Protection Authority (ERSPA) has an established Source Protection Committee (SPC), which follows the guidance of Ontario Regulation 288/07 (O.Reg 288/07). The SPC is composed of 15 members, including five (5) representatives from the municipal sector. The remaining two-thirds of the SPC are representatives of key industries (e.g. agriculture, greenhouse operations, and fuel suppliers) and members of the public at large. At this time, one municipal member is retiring from his position on the SPC and one municipal member has taken a new position and can no longer sit on the SPC.

In 2007, the ERSPA striking committee determined the following composition of municipal representation on the SPC, which was endorsed by all member municipalities:

- City of Windsor 2 members
- Union Water Supply System 1 member

- Town of Lakeshore 1 member
- Town of Amherstburg 1 member

The striking committee felt that those municipalities responsible for the Water Treatment Plants that provide the largest water supplies should have the opportunity to have representation on the SPC.

In the spring of 2024, the term of appointment for Mayor Dennis Rogers, representing Union Water Supply System (UWSS), came to a close when he took on a position as a member of on the Source Protection Authority. The UWSS Board selected Deputy Mayor Kirk Walstedt as their nominee for representation on the SPC.

Albert Dionne, who represented the Town of Lakeshore retired from his role in 2023. Mr. Jason Barlow, Division Lead of Water Management has been selected as their nominee for representation on the SPC.

Both Mayor Rogers and Mr. Dionne were valued members of the SPC and will be missed. We look forward to working with the newly selected members.

Ms. Antonietta has been representing the Town of Amherstburg on the SPC for many years. The current term of her appointment expires in November 2024 and we are pleased that Ms. Giofu will be continuing in this role.

In keeping with our previous practices, a letter was sent to all member Municipalities on July 29, 2024, requesting that municipal councils endorse the following individuals' appointment to the Essex Region Source Protection Committee:

- **Kirk Walstedt, Union Water Supply System,** expected appointment date: November 14, 2024; term of appointment: 5 years
- **Jason Barlow, Municipality of Lakeshore,** expected appointment date: November 14, 2024; term of appointment: 5 years
- **Antonietta Giofu, Town of Amherstburg,** expected appointment date: November 14, 2024; term of appointment: 5 years

Municipalities were asked to send their response in the form of Council Resolutions by September 30, 2024. Resolutions from all member municipalities endorsing the appointment of the above-named individuals to the SPC were received prior to the writing of this report.

Caldwell First Nation Chief and Council have approved Steve Simpson Sr. to represent their interests on the SPC. Mr. Simpson will replace their previously appointed SPC member, Ms. Jenna Maidment. Mr. Simpson is a Water Guardian and Caldwell First Nation community

member. We are pleased to welcome him to the SPC, appointed under Section 6(3) of O.Reg 288/07.
