Don't forget to give a public shoutout to your supporters! This is another great way to share information about the event and boost your pledges.




How to raise funds for this year's Bike Tour by using your donation page to send auto-generated messages to your friends and supporters

## Use Race Roster's form tools

### To send auto-generated messages

1. Log in to the Bike Tour page on Race Roster.
2. Click "**sign in**" at the top right of the page and enter your email and password. This will return you to the Bike Tour's page.
3. Click "**Menu**" at the top right of the page. A dropdown menu will appear.
4. Click "**Dashboard**", located near the middle of the dropdown menu. This will take you to your individual home page.
5. In the "**Fundraising**" area on the lower right of your individual page...
6. **Click one of the three buttons:** share to Facebook, Twitter, or an auto-generated Email. You may be asked to enter your Facebook or Twitter credentials.
7. An "Ask Your Friends For Donations" screen will appear. You may choose to enter an optional message at the top.
8. Enter your supporter's name and email address. You can add multiple names and addresses by clicking on the "+" button, and remove them by clicking on the "-" button.
9. When you are satisfied with your message and recipients, click the "**send**" button on the bottom of this page.
